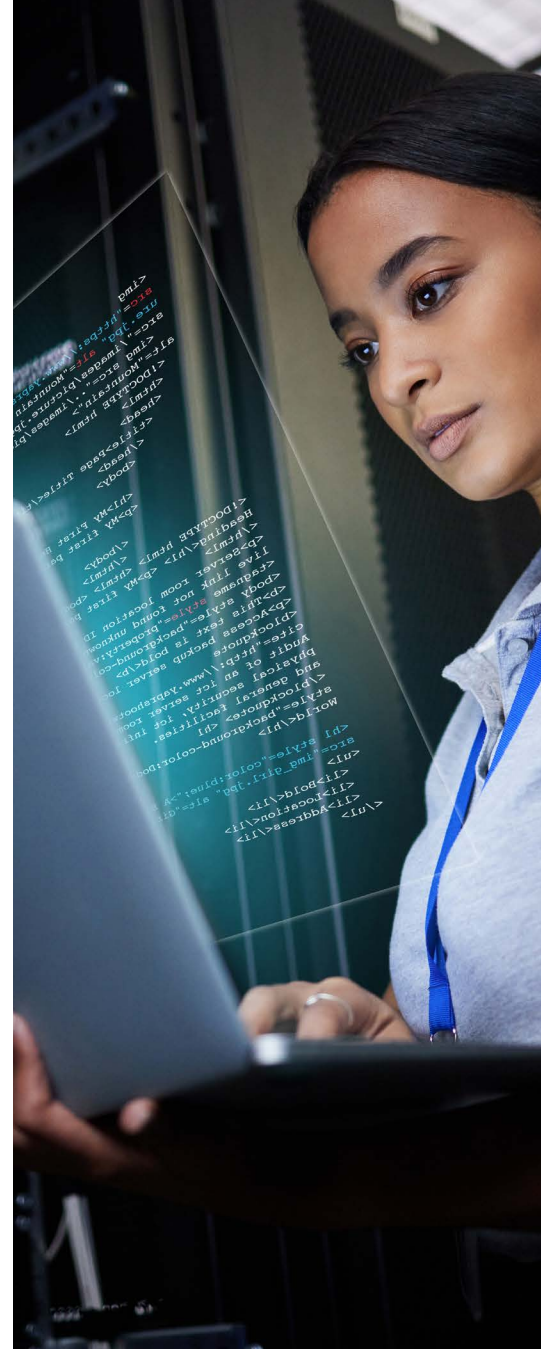


Cybersecurity Maturity Assessment

A Cybersecurity Maturity Assessment identifies your company's current risk rating and establishes your target maturity risk level.

The assessment helps to:

- Evaluate the maturity level of key cybersecurity domains and controls against specific actionable and measurable minimum maturity requirements across each domain.
- Identify gaps in your cybersecurity program across people, processes, and technology.
- Align and map cyber practices against industry standards e.g., NIST and ISO 27001.
- Develop an action plan to help reduce your cybersecurity attack risk.

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Client Vendor Assessment

The Client Vendor Assessment provides a useful snapshot of the risks associated with a specific vendor.

The assessment identifies:

- If the vendor can do the job, have an industry presence, reputation for quality products or services, and adhere to sound operating practices.
- If the vendor matches your own standards and codes of conduct.
- If the vendor can be trusted to not misuse intellectual property or confidential information and respect and adhere to data privacy regulations and take adequate steps to do so.



Cloud Assessment (AWS and O365)

A Cloud Security Assessment evaluates the security posture of a cloud computing environment based on industry best practices.

The assessment identifies:

- The effectiveness of the security controls implemented in the cloud environment. This includes assessing access controls, encryption, network security, and other security measures.
- Potential vulnerabilities in the cloud environment, including misconfigurations, access control issues, and other security gaps.
- Areas where improvements are necessary and to help create a plan to remediate any identified issues or vulnerabilities.

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
